

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, ABUSE, & NEGLECT

YOUR REPORT COULD SAVE A LIFE

North Carolina law requires any person who has cause to suspect that a juvenile under 18 is being abused, neglected, or is dependent to make a report. This is known as universal mandated reporting. Some states require only certain professionals to make reports, but in North Carolina, the duty to report extends to everyone.

If you suspect child abuse or neglect in Wilkes County, report it to the Wilkes County Department of Social Services at (336) 651-7400 and your local law enforcement agency immediately. **If you witness child abuse, call 911.**
